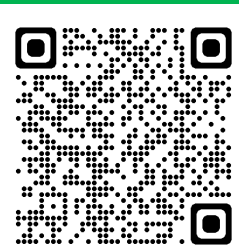

Please join us in congratulating Roger Darr as the SVDP District 8 Top Hat of 2024! The Top Hat award is given annually to a Vincentian who provides an outstanding example of the core Vincentian values of friendship, spirituality, and service. The "Top Hat" title is used to emphasize that the Society's founder, Frederic Ozanam, who did not allow his social class, in which men wore top hats, to blind him to the needs of the poor in early nineteenth century France.

Some highlights of Roger's service to SVDP -

- o Attends Mass regularly and all special SVDP events – Rosary Rally, Thanksgiving Baskets, Angel Tree, Coffee and Donuts Sundays with SVDP.
- o Frequently hand delivers checks to vendors to insure rent/utilities are paid before they are at risk of being evicted or utilities disconnected.
- o Written over 4,100 checks. On call every day for last 12 years.
- o Creates reports that: train Vincentians; help caseworkers; promote our conference; inform our supporters. Written over 150 Monthly and 13 Annual Reports, 11 Annual Parish Letters, 20 Grant applications, 8 Appreciation Event presentations.
- o Supports and trains 15 Conference Treasurers in Districts 7 & 8, significantly contributing to Council's successful annual audit.
- o Served on the Banks/Jackson Food Bank Board for 9 years. Implemented conference buying meat from Council and delivering to food bank 2x a month.

Roger's calm, thoughtful demeanor and desire to always do what is right in the eyes of God centers the discussion and the group. Roger treats EVERYONE with

respect and dignity. His faith is evident through his interactions with others. He is dependable. When Roger says he will do something for a Case Worker it gets done without regard to his personal situation. Roger serves as our Conference Treasure, District Treasurer for 2 districts, and sits on the Thrift Store Board.
