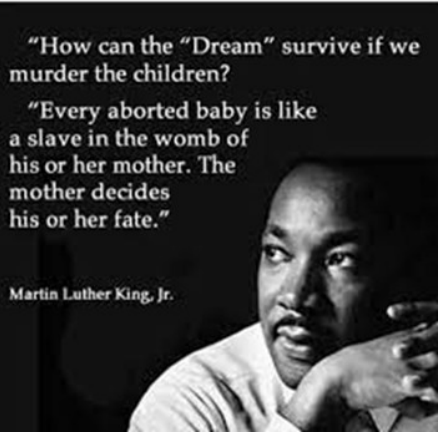

From the Pastor - As our country celebrates an American hero, Martin Luther King, Jr., this Monday, we give thanks to God for his Civil Rights movement to bring equality to all people, no matter their race, and the promotion of human dignity to all who belong to the human race. God created us all equal and in his image and likeness from the first moment of our conception. Unfortunately, many human beings in America still don't have an equal right to life just because of where they live: Inside the womb of their mothers. Even though our Supreme Court followed the Pro-Life spirit of MLK and declared that the U.S. Constitution doesn't allow for abortion, tragically it is still legal to kill an unborn child in most states. So we need to continue the fight for the right to life. This Thursday January 22 the Catholic Church in America calls for all the faithful to pray and fast for the end of legalized abortion and the protection of unborn children. Case Example:
“Jane” called SVdP looking for assistance with rent. As a result of spousal abuse, Jane was unable to work for several weeks and lost income for that period of time. Subsequently, it was determined that she and her 2 kids needed to relocate. Fortunately, her employer was willing to work with her and transferred her to a job in Commerce. They were even willing to help with some of her moving expenses but she still needed help. SVdP was able to pay her first month’s rent as well as other miscellaneous expenses (including gifts from the Angel Tree for her kids). Today Jane is safe, fully employed and immensely thankful for the support she received.
