Dear parish family of St. Catherine's,

I am very blessed to be assigned here for the summer and next spring as a transitional deacon. I am grateful for Father Tim who is taking me under his wing and mentoring me this year as I prepare for priestly ordination next summer. I have much to learn as a new deacon and hope to grow in my diaconal identity in my time here at St. Catherine's.

I come from a small family with parents and younger sister. I was born in Boca Raton, Florida and lived in the South Florida area as a child. My father's job moved us to Alpharetta, GA in 2009 and ever since, I have called Atlanta my home. I attended Alpharetta High School then moved to Georgia College and State University where I obtained my Bachelors of Business Administration degree in Management in 2018.

I became involved in my Catholic faith in college after I had a powerful encounter with Jesus in the Sacrament of Confession. After this confession, I began to pray and worship regularly. Indeed, I began to lead and serve more in my catholic community. Slowly but surely I began to hear the call to priesthood. But before the call to priesthood, God put on my heart the missionary call, especially to serve college students.

I was heavily involved with FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) in college. FOCUS is an apostolate in the Church that evangelizes college students. Upon graduation from college I answered the call to serve as a FOCUS missionary and I was assigned to serve the college students at the University of Memphis and served there for two years. During this time, the call to priesthood became an even stronger desire of my heart. After a 8-day silent retreat in my second year, it was clear I had to move to seminary to see if God was really calling to the priesthood.

I haven't looked back since. By God's grace, I have endured the mountainous terrain that is the formation journey to the priesthood with much peace and joy. Or should I say the sunny beach-side formational journey at St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton BEACH in South Florida. It has been a beautiful and grace-filled six years in priestly formation and only one more year to go! As I embark on this last year in seminary as a transitional deacon as a part of this beloved parish family, I hope to grow in love for God's holy people. Praying for yall!

Possible SVDP Case of the Month

A single mother of 3 young children called needing help with rent. Her youngest broke his leg and although she has Blue Cross and Medicaid, the hospital only filed with Blue Cross and then told the mom she had to pay the rest. So she started making payments of \$643 each month to the hospital. She has a good job but this payment amount set her back so that by the time she called us she was going to be \$500 short on the rent. Our standard limit is \$300. Mom says she can make up the difference by going to the Blood Bank and Door Dashing. We asked her to hold off on that and the conference made a decision to pay the full amount. We spent time talking with her about the need for child support from the children's father who is not in the picture. We discussed budgeting and gave her additional resources. We also recommended she get in touch with the hospital and request they put the claim to Medicaid, and then to call Medicaid and see if she can get reimbursed for what she has already paid.
